A guardian is a person who is appointed by the court of make decisions about the care of another person. In addition to making decisions about the care of another person, who is sometimes called a " ward, " a guardian might also be responsible for managing the financial affairs and property of the ward. This is often called a conservatorship.

Guardianship is a legal process that allows someone (usually a family member) to ask the court to find that a person age 18 or older is unable (incompetent) to manage his/her affairs effectively because of a disability. A guardian steps in the shoes of the person with a disability and makes decisions in the individual ' s best interest.

Types of Guardianships in Utah There are two general types of guardianship: (1) a full guardianship, where all decision-making authority is removed from the protected person and transferred to the guardian to exercise; and (2) a limited guardianship, where some rights are transferred to the guardian while some are retained by the protected person.
