As you move up the chart, the materials have a higher attraction for negative electrons. Ex: PVC will attract electrons more than silk. If PVC and silk are rubbed together, PVC will strip electrons off of silk creating an overall negative charge on the PVC because it has a higher attraction for electrons.
